# **Summary report on LCC Council meeting**

Held Feb. 4-5, 2014

The LCC Council was convened for the first time Feb. 4-5, 2014 in Washington DC by Envirolssues and the Udall Foundation, US Institute for Environmental Conflict Resolution. **Below** are the key messages and outcomes the Council identified to describe their two days' work.

#### Key messages:

- The LCC Council enthusiastically affirmed their role to support the LCCs and facilitate the work they do to support a sustainable network
- The LCC Council has a shared commitment to landscape scale conservation and the unique contribution of the LCCs
- Recognizing the Council's desire for inclusivity across the Landscape Conservation Cooperative (LCC) Network, the Council reflected this in their name - LCC Council

#### Meeting outcomes:

- The LCC Council developed a broad framework for actions to support the LCCs
- The LCC Council selected leadership (two co-chairs). Co-chairs selected were Marc Miller (executive director of Illinois' Department of Natural Resources, the Midwest Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies' member) and Lynn Scarlet (TNC's policy director, one of four NGO members).
- Seeking to clarify role its role, the LCC Council established three working groups:
  - o Communications Marc Miller, David Whitehurst, Terry Williams
  - Strategic Planning (jointly with the LCC Network) Jeff Raasch, Eric Schroff, Terry Williams, Madeline Maley, Leslie Honey
  - Charter refining Jeff Raasch, Mallory Martin, Mary Wagner, Madeline Maley,
     Gary Tabor, Ulalila Woodside, Leslie Honey
- Started to develop a better understanding of the relationship of LCCs to other landscape conservation efforts/initiatives
- The LCC Council will reach out to LCCs to understand barriers to success, help address these barriers and to celebrate successes
- Council members were asked to send any specific contacts or suggested organizations to help with recruitment for the Mexico participant and additional tribal participants.

There was much discussion and almost universal agreement about the self-directed nature of the LCCs and how the Council would not be a governing body but rather wanted to understand challenges and successes of the LCCs so they can better help. There was a general theme of the Council wanting to help the LCCs succeed at achieving their vision of sustainable landscapes for current and future generations.

The Council will hold an interim conference call in April and expect to meet again in person in June and either September or October.
